

## Surgical and Pre-anesthetic Consent

Your cat is scheduled for a procedure that may require sedation and/or anesthesia at Just Cats Veterinary Hospital (JCVH). There are risks with any surgery, sedation, or anesthesia – even in animals that appear healthy. Such risks include, but are not limited to, infection at the surgical site, unexpected blood loss, and complications up to and including loss of life. JCVH takes several measures to minimize these risks, but cannot guarantee an outcome for the medical treatments performed.

**It is critical that you provide a phone number where you can be reached in an emergency or to discuss the findings of pre-anesthetic testing. The procedure may be delayed if we cannot contact you.**

### The following are mandatory due to Just Cats' medical and safety protocols.

- When necessary, an intravenous (IV) catheter will be placed to provide access to the bloodstream.
- When necessary, the patient will be intubated with a breathing tube to secure the airway.
- In case of an emergency, the veterinarian will perform what treatments they consider necessary in the best interest of your pet. JCVH will make every attempt to contact you if such an event occurs.

### The following are optional. Please check off the options you want performed.

We highly recommend a pre-anesthetic blood test. It is run in-house and checks immune system and organ function to help determine if the individual can process sedation/anesthesia. This is recommended for patients of all ages and health status, but especially for patients with comorbidities or increased age.

Please perform the recommended pre-anesthetic profile. (\$97)

Please DO NOT perform the pre-anesthetic test.

We also offer an in-house blood test that measures cardiac muscle stretch called a proBNP. This test can help determine if a cat may have an underlying heart condition that could impact their ability to be safely sedated/anesthetized. If the result is negative, it is unlikely the cat has heart disease. If positive, the doctor will call to discuss.

Please perform the proBNP test to measure cardiac muscle stretch. (\$86)

Please DO NOT perform the proBNP test.

We recommend all cats have a microchip, even if they are indoors. If your cat does not already have one, we can place a microchip today.

Yes, please insert a microchip. (\$103)
